Valeria's cocktail bar and night spot opened its doors in the summer of 2019 and is a hidden gem within the grounds of one of the UKs most luxurious 5* hotel and spa retreats, Grantley Hall.


Audio

Valeria's is a subterranean venue, found underneath the main events space at Grantley Hall, from the moment you enter the building, digital signage displays line the route to guide you to the venue, with music from Bowers & Wilkins loudspeakers and Crestron amplification, accompanying you on that journey. From the moment you push the doors to the venue open, you know that you've stepped into a special space.


The circular bar in the centre, where skilled bar staff serve exquisite cocktails and champagne, is enveloped by comfortable booths, with a DJ area next

to the small dancefloor. The entire space is filled with high performance technology, K-array column speakers and high-performance subwoofers were selected and hidden wherever possible. Working closely with architects, interior designers and on-site contractors, Clever Association managed to keep many of the larger speakers and subwoofers out of sight, with bespoke cabinets and seating booths being used to great effect.

The music is served from a customised playlist selection, maintained constantly updated by C-Burn. The DJ can then override this playlist and take control of the venue through Pioneer decks, pushing the sound system just a little harder you then realise what the system is truly capable of. Input plates in this location allow live acts to connect into the venue sound system as and when the need might arise too. The music played in the venue continues in the toilets and surround corridors so that the entire venue is on brand throughout.

Working closely with architects, interior designers and on-site contractors, Clever Association worked carefully to ensure that sound is contained within the venues, and ensuring that many of the larger speakers and subwoofers are out of sight, with bespoke cabinets and seating booths being used to great effect. Audio limiting hardware was put into place so that the risk of sound disturbances to guests in the hotel, adjacent venues or neighbouring properties are minimised.

Video

A ceiling mounted Canon video projector coupled with a Spinetix media player gives the team the ability to push new and relevant content for display above the dancefloor. This may be the venue logo and complimentary visual effects or graphics specific to a particular event or live act.

Lighting

Surrounding the circular bar, a custommade truss that carries more loudspeakers is also used for the mounting of Chauvet colour changing and moving disco lights. These are a great addition for setting subtle colour effects for specific events or for making the atmosphere a little livelier during live music or a DJ set. House lighting throughout Valeria's and the entire building is all automated via a Lutron lighting control system, automated throughout the day to set the perfect aesthetic while ensuring the Grantley Hall team can work effectively.

Control

To automate and control all technologies within the venue, Clever Association designed a Crestron control system that allows the various entertainment and lighting solutions to be automated or manually adjusted throughout the day. It is important that the entire venue looks and performs at its best at all times and this can be achieved with little to no input from the team. When hosting a wedding or other large event, automated lighting scenes can be overridden, setting up specific colours in the venues, to perfectly match the occasion.
